**Margarete von Wrangell** was the first *female* full professor in Germany appointed to the Chair of Plant Nutrition at Hohenheim in 1923. Thus, she was also the founder of the Institute of Plant Nutrition, whose professorships are nowadays part of the Institute of Crop Sciences. A major focus of her work was phosphate supply of plants and phosphate mobility in the soil, both of which are still and again highly important topics. The 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Margaret von Wrangell's appointment was the occasion to host this year's annual conference of the German Society of Plant Nutrition at the University of Hohenheim.
